STEPS TO FOLLOW

The first step to obtaining a marriage certificate is registering at the Fiscalía de Estado Civil (City Clerk). There, the couple will be charged a fee for their registration.

The documents listed below will be required at the time of registration. To ensure that they will not be lost in the mail, the couple can send copies of the documents and then present the originals in person upon arrival.

*Passports

*Birth Certificates

*Certificate that proves civil status

*If divorced, documents of divorce or annulment

Two witnesses, outside of those who will be performing the marriage ceremony, must be present. If the witnesses are not Dominican, they must present their passports to prove their identities.

Civil Ceremony

Once the marriage has taken place, the Justice of the Peace must present the documents to the Fiscalía del Estado Civil, which will then authorize a certificate of marriage that is legally recognized around the world.

Religious Ceremony

A religious ceremony has many more formalities than a civil ceremony. If you wish to wed in a church or synagogue, it's best for a wedding planner to coordinate all of the details. You must fulfill all of the requirements for a civil ceremony as well as other formalities specifically required by the church. For example, if you wish to have a Catholic marriage, the Archbishop must request permission from the Diocese where the wedding will take place.
